NEW YORK TRANSCO ANNOUNCES PRESIDENT FOLLOWING NATIONAL SEARCH

Joris Veldhoven Selected as Incoming President

Rye Brook, NY – New York Transco today announced the selection of Joris Veldhoven to serve as its next president following the conclusion of a national search. Veldhoven is the successor to the current President Victor Mullin, who will retire at the end of March.

Veldhoven will begin his tenure as president on March 2. Veldhoven has over 15 years of experience in the energy sector, including executive leadership, complex project and supply chain management, and stakeholder engagement. A Brooklyn resident, his most recent role was as CEO & President of Atlantic Shores Offshore Wind. He holds a bachelor's degree in Industrial Engineering and Management Science and a master's degree in Industrial Engineering and Innovation Management from Eindhoven University of Technology.

Mullin, who has led New York Transco since 2019 and positioned the company as a leader in modernizing and expanding New York's electric transmission infrastructure, will aid in a seamless transition before his retirement. Under Mullin, New York Transco placed nearly \$1 billion of new assets into service, including the complex construction of approximately 70 miles of new and upgraded electric transmission and several substations safely, on time and on budget, and has grown the organization's staffing and capabilities.
